

What are Mock Interviews?

- Focus on practicing behavioral question
 - Was there ever a time where you had conflict with someone, and how did you handle it?
 - Give an example of a time you failed and how you overcame it.
- Will help participants become more comfortable and confident.

FINANCIAL LITERACY

Financial literacy is defined as having the set of skills and knowledge that allows an individual to make informed and effective decisions with all their financial resources for a lifetime of financial well-being. Because learning personal finance is extremely difficult to learn on your own, Auberle's 412 Program focuses on navigating these young adults through our complex financial system. Financial literacy can be anything from information connected to math or history, learning how to write-out/understand a check, comprehending how to pay off a credit card, to understanding one's credit score.

MOCK INTERVIEWS
